If this is not a number, but a symbol beginning with X or U, the course has transferred, but not as a specific UWM course. The U denotes that upper-division credit is being granted (Letters & Science courses only).

If there are characters to the right, this is how they should be interpreted. The 2nd character indicates whether a course carries General Education credit:

A	Arts (see third course above as an example)
H	Humanities
N	Natural Science
S	Social Science
X	No additional General Education information (placeholder)

The third character may also contain General Education information:

&	Cultural Diversity
+	Natural Science Lab
X	No additional General Education information (placeholder)

If there is a fourth character, here is how it should be interpreted:

I	Studio Art course
V	Survey Art course
P	Physical Geography course
T	Cultural Geography course

W	Science course contains lab (but does not satisfy GER)
L	English literature course
C	English composition course

If there is a "Z" at the end, the course counts for credit, but cannot be counted toward a major in that subject.

The Art course above would be interpreted as Art Survey credit with General Education credit for Arts, and no credit toward an Art major.
